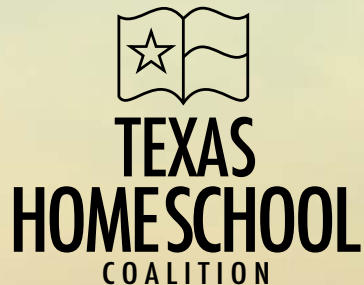

GENERAL INFORMATION

BOOK CHECK For your convenience, a Book Check area will be available in the Exhibit Hall for your books and purchases during the hours the Exhibit Hall is open. You may leave your purchases to be stored safely until 5:30pm on Friday and 5:30pm on Saturday. No overnight storage is available.

CONCESSIONS AND DINING The Woodlands Waterway Hotel has several grab and go food options onsite and there are eating establishments within a short distance from the hotel. No outside food is permitted in the convention.

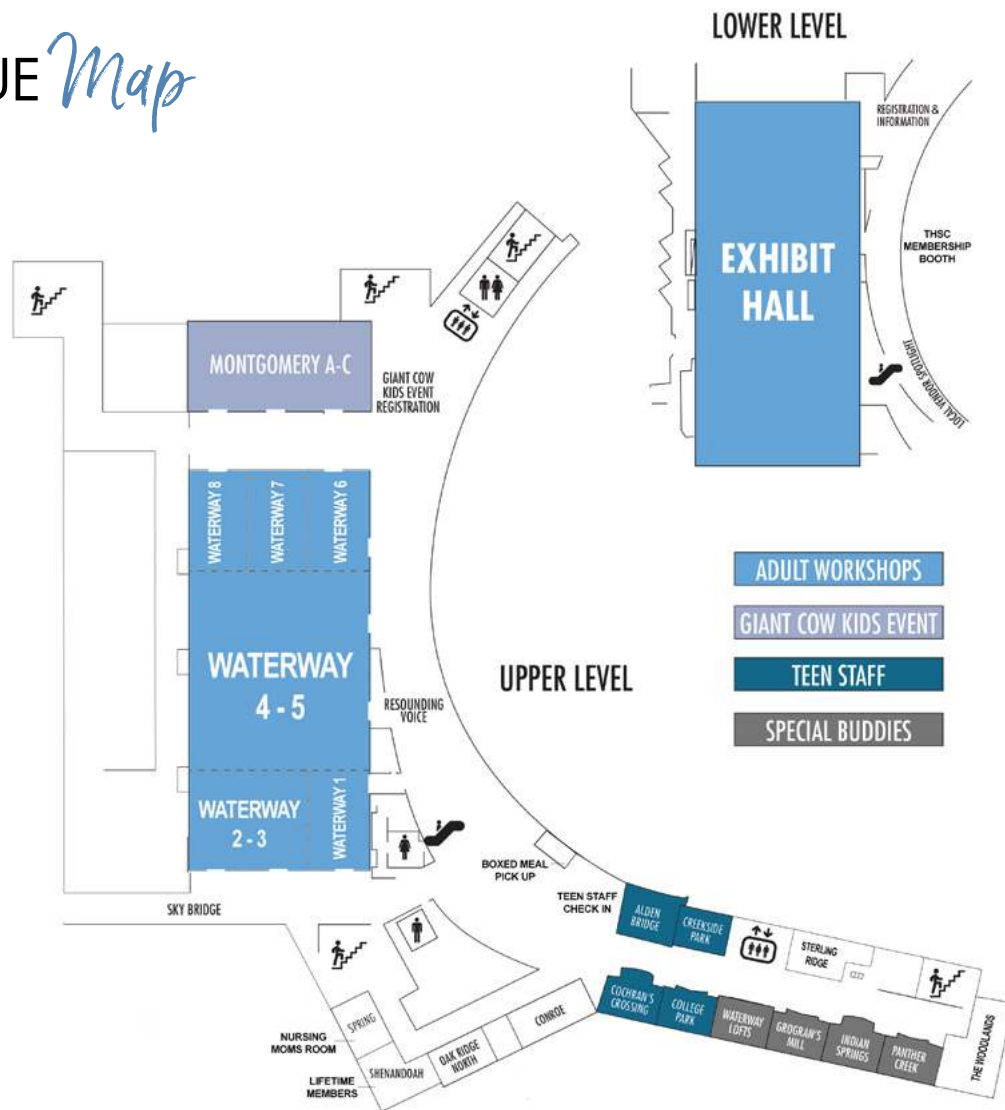

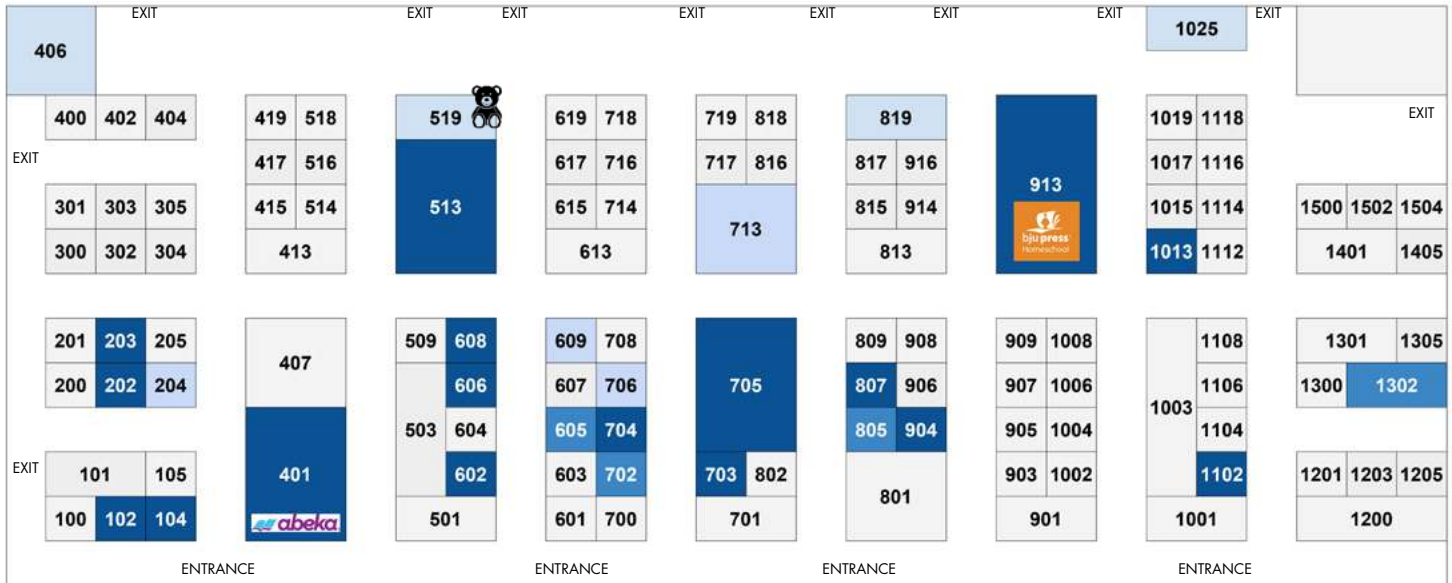

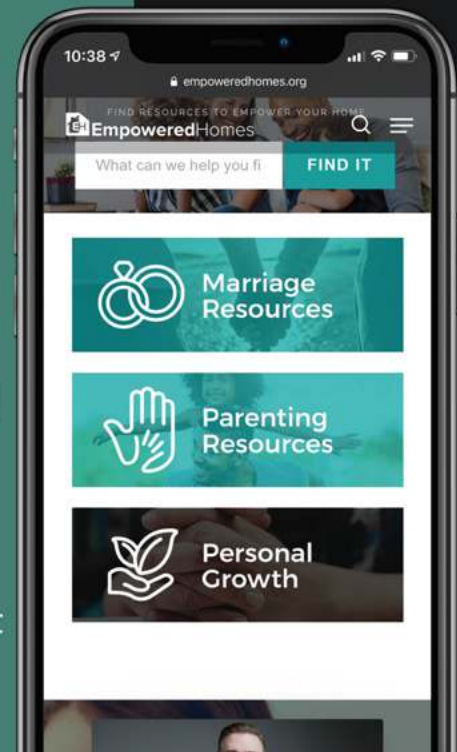
